
## Windows Email App Earns Award as Worst Ever Email App

## This app is a POS



Somebody sends you an email that is a reply to or forward of an email that contained an image. If you are using that awful mail app that came with Windows 10 you can see where that image should be, but you cannot see the image.



It indicates that the image is loading, but it never does. If you try to reply to the message you get this warning: "Download in progress. If you reply, your message may be incomplete." You are prompted to "Reply anyway" or "Dismiss." If you select "Reply anyway" the email window shows a blank message with dots moving left to right, indicating that the moronic client is still trying to download the image with success. Your reply will never be sent.



I have resolved this problem by downloading <u>Thunderbird</u>, an old but dandy email client, which does not have problems like this.
