MyWeb at ECU

In the summer of 2021 accounts on MyWeb were moved to a new secure server. IMHO, this was done in a way that creates little if any difficulty for faculty who use this web server. Here is my discussion with Matt (a great guy) in ITCS about this.

Karl.

I have moved your content from the psyc folder on the basic web space to your new folder on the secure web space. The old links should properly redirect to the new location.

For example, here's one link from your old space: http://core.ecu.edu/psyc/wuenschk/klw.htm. If you click on that link and look in the browser's address bar you'll notice it redirected to the new website without the 'psyc' in the URL: https://core.ecu.edu/wuenschk/klw.htm. You will also notice it's using the secure protocol (https).

Note: some browsers don't show the protocol, but it will show a 'lock' icon beside the URL.

To access and edit your files you may connect via PiratePanel, network path, or FTP. That info is shown below and also available at

Network path (you will need to be on campus or connected to VPN)

- macOS smb://myweb/secure/wuenschk

FTP settings – also must be logged in to the VPN to FTP I find FTP a lot easier than mapping a drive, since a mapped drive must be recreated for each VPN session.

host: ftpmywebsecure.ecu.edu

port: 2021

encryption: Require explicit FTP over TLS

user: intra\wuenschk

Once you have enabled VPN on your PC all you need do to connect is Start, Cisco, Cisco Secure Connect Mobility Client. Each time a verification code will be sent to your cell phone. https://ecu.teamdynamix.com/TDClient/1409/Portal/KB/ArticleDet?ID=67337

Thanks for the quick reply. No, access to view the website will not change. The move to the secure space simply means that we will be enforcing the secure protocol (https) for all websites.

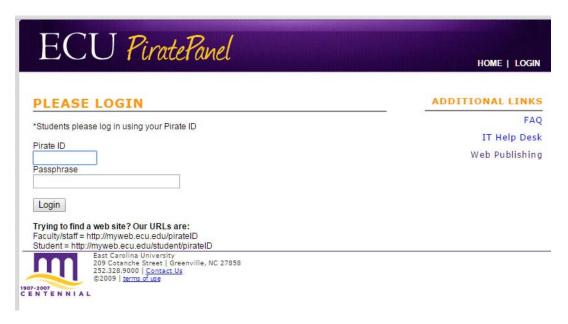

For example, once the content is moved the link in your signature file: http://core.ecu.edu/psyc/wuenschk/klw.htm will redirect visitors to https://core.ecu.edu/wuenschk/klw.htm. Notice the new link will be https and no longer includes "psyc".

There is no downtime during this transition either. Let me know when you're ready and I'll move the content and provide you with the correct link to access your content in your new secure space.

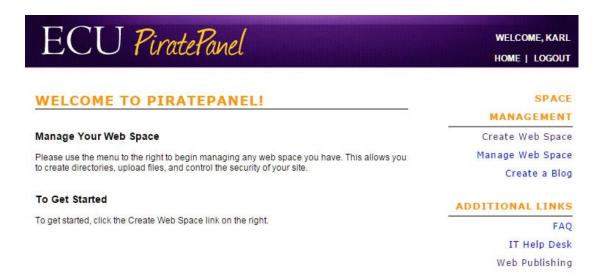

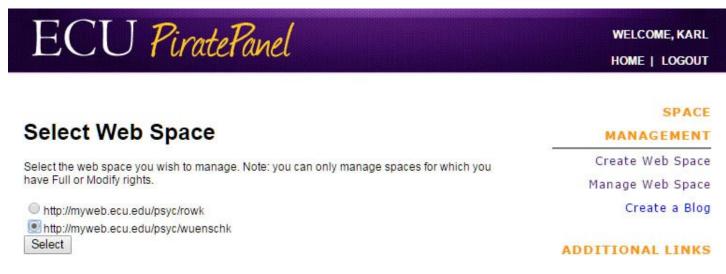

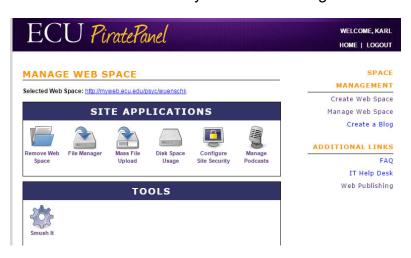
Provide your Pirate ID and password. You then advance to this screen:



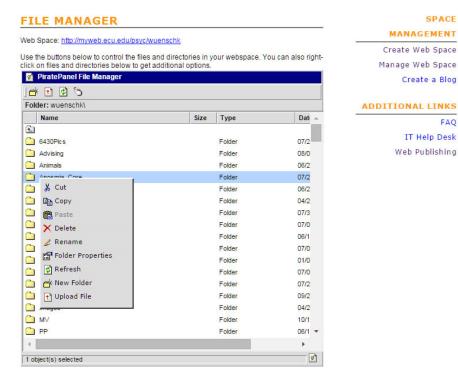
Click on "Create Web Space" to create an account. If you already have an account, you can click on "Manage Web Space to advance to the screen shown below.



Select the account you wish to manage and then click Select. You advance to the next page.
