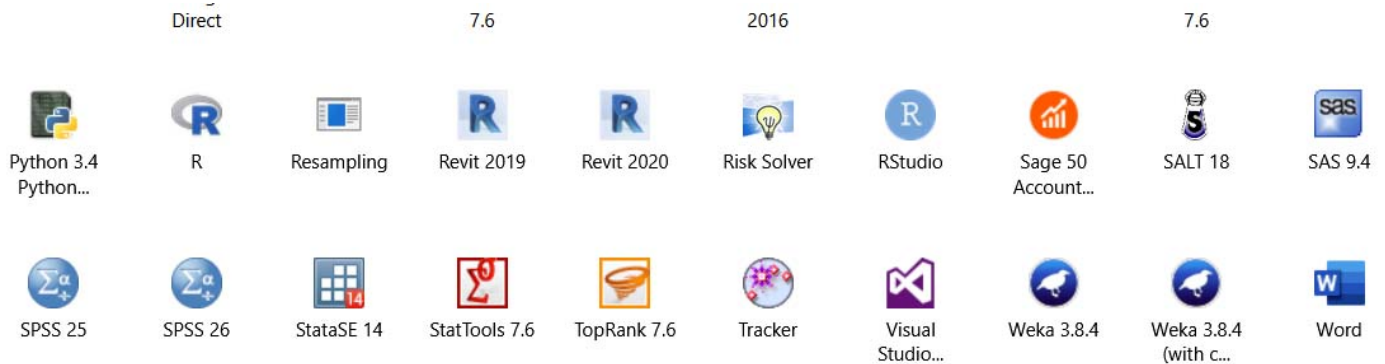


Using the VCL to Run SAS 9.4

- Go to <http://vcl.ecu.edu>
- Click on “New VCL Login”
- Log in.
- The Azure Windows Virtual Desktop appears. There are lots of apps there. Here is a display of some of them:



- Boot up SAS and click File, Import Data. Step through the Wizard. I imported an SPSS data file. Asked to allow access to printer and clipboard, I allowed. I am asked for my login credentials again.
- I selected to import a file that is located on my Pirate Drive. I was unable to access files on my PC. I would show you a screenshot, but Azure seems to disallow screen shots.
- I want some simple statistics, and the results displayed in the remote results window, but when I save them to the “Desktop” they must have gone to the desktop of the remote computer, not to mine. I have been unable to figure out how to access that Desktop. So I saved the mht results to my PirateDrive and downloaded them from there to my PC.
